BOB KIVELA LAYOUT Bob has a large, multi-level, 3-rail O gauge layout. It is modeled to represent the mid 1950s, with both post-war and modern equipment. Bob uses MTH digital control for all of train operation. Many pieces are custom painted for New England Railroads. The layout spans 60 feet long, arguably the longest three rail layout in New England. Trains operate on two mainlines on the lower loop and one on the upper loop. This is truly a great model railroad.



Bob's train layout is located on the <u>second floor and is not handicap accessible</u>. One way driving time (return to hotel): 1 hour 30 minutes (76.4 miles)
