The Cold Hollow Cider Mill is one of the top producers of Fresh Apple Cider in all of New England. They are also one of the very few that press year-round. Come and sample cider that's still made the old-fashioned way, with a rack and cloth press built in the 1920's.

Observe 100% pure, natural Maple Syrup packed on the filling line and see Maple Candy being made with vintage equipment. You will experience multimedia displays in a real woodshed theater, a nature trail, country store, and an outdoor Vermont farm life museum. Stroll into the Sugar House Museum and learn about 'The Whole Sugaring Experience' ... and finally browse in the spacious red-roofed Cabin Shop, full of Maple Grove Farms of Vermont factory-direct products. Sprinkled throughout are whimsical carved folk life characters created by Burr Morse.
